## Changing the scope of the EU Emissions Trading Scheme

After months of negotiations, the EU is about to adopt the Fit for 55 package: a set of **legislative reforms** that embody the impressive dynamics and the level of ambition of the European Union's climate policy. In the latest report of the <u>Centre for Climate and Energy Analyses</u> (CAKE), we highlight the **impacts of these developments on the economy of the EU and Poland until 2050**, discussing several options of **extending emissions trading to new sectors** with a significant impact on the future of the green transformation in our part of the globe.

The results of our analysis may provide **useful guidance to those developing countries** that are looking at supporting the implementation of their climate policies through fully-fledged and Paris Agreement-compatible carbon markets, with a view to the future linking for a truly global impact.
